
CLC'S OCTOBER NEWSLETTER

I know many of you having been waiting anxiously for the photo proofs to arrive, they should be here this Friday or coming Monday!!


We are happy to announce we have a new lending Library in the office for your child to check out a book. Please stop by the office on your way in or out to sign out a book to take home and read, then return for a new one.
